COURSE CONTENTS

The course will cover the study of tablatures for lute, vihuela, guitar, and related instruments, and will provide the necessary skills for transcribing them into modern notation. The various types of tablature used between the early 16th century and the mid-18th century will be examined, with an overview of the literature and major publications.
