<p><b>COURSE CONTENTS</b></p> <p>This sector concerns the acquisition of a basic linguistic preparation (level A1 + A2) in reference to the parameters of the European Framework of linguistic competence. A1: Basic level, able to communicate in everyday situations  A2: Elementary level, able to communicate in simple situations  B1: Intermediate level, able to communicate in more complex situations, including professional contexts.</p> <p>In this interactive and engaging course, students will learn the essential musical terminology in English and develop the skills to communicate effectively in a professional music setting. Through a combination of lectures, discussions, games, and hands-on activities, students will gain a solid understanding of English language usage in the music industry.</p>
